U.S.DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD)

This is a revised Public Notice to original notice published June 15, 2016. The original Notice informed the public of the PY16 Annual Action Plan and uses of all HOME grant funding that included Rehabilitation and Reconstruction of substandard single family home owner occupied houses and the funding of the Grand Prairie Community Housing and Development Organization. This Notice is to inform the Public of a new program that will build affordable housing units in conjunction with the Grand Prairie Independent School District for qualified City of Grand Prairie Section 8 Homeownership participant families.

As part of the revised notice the City of Grand Prairie is holding a public comment period from November 28, 2016 through December 27, 2016 to receive public comments concerning a proposed change in use of \$70,000 in HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds (HOME) grant funds based on an amendment to the City's 2016 Action Plan. The HOME funds were originally earmarked for Rehabilitation/Reconstruction Activity with a total budget amount of \$270,347.

The proposed change would reduce this amount down to \$200,347 and fund the construction of one Affordable Housing unit benefitting a certified eligible low to moderate income qualified City of Grand Prairie Section 8 Homeownership family.

The (30) day comment period will commence on November 28, 2016. All comments must be received no later than 5:00 pm December 27, 2016.
